POSITION SUMMARY

Food Service Workers are primarily responsible for operating our friendly Johnny Appleseed's Café and Peter's Pumpkin Espresso and keeping Children's Fairyland an inviting, safe and happy place to visit. Food Service Workers (FSW) are a main point of contact between Fairyland and our guests, and are critical to our success. FSW must be very flexible, reliable, responsible, and adaptable to handle a variety of duties and work well under pressure while remaining courteous, friendly, and helpful to all guests and staff.

Food Service Workers must:

- Maintain a clean, neat and food safe environment and observe all food safety and hygiene regulations and practices
- Assist with food preparation, dishwashing, cooking, cashiering, cleaning, stocking, managing inventory
- Maintain clean and tidy appearance and uniform (2 CFL shirts will be provided and aprons are available for daily use)
- Bring a positive and productive energy to work, including clean uniform, well-groomed, neat and tidy appearance appropriate for a food service environment and children's park
- Pay attention to detail, work closely with staff members, represent Children's Fairyland in a professional and courteous manner
- Have an excellent attendance record
- Not use cell phones while on duty
- Follow all procedures of the park and the Food Service operation

Physical Requirements

This position requires the ability to: stand, sit, kneel, walk, bend, perform repetitive motions, lift 50lbs safely, have good hearing and sight, strong communication skills and the ability to work in all types of weather.

Pay and Hours

This is a part-time, non-exempt position with a maximum of 30 hours per week. Employees will be assigned shifts according to the company needs, including shifts on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays. The 5 day season – Wednesday through Sunday runs from April 5, 2017 through June 5, 2017. The 7 day season – runs June 7 through August 20, 2017. Shifts are typically within the hours of 9am-5pm depending on the season. Some evenings are required for special events.

Oakland minimum wage and/or Oakland living wage apply. The park does not operate when it rains.
