POSITION SUMMARY: The Maintenance Worker's main focus is the park itself; performing building, plumbing, and electrical tasks. That could include digging a hole to cleaning gutters to building and painting a complete new structure. Must be available to work weekends and holidays as needed.

Essential Job Functions:

- Under direct supervision of the Facilities Manager, perform a variety of skilled and semi-skilled building, maintenance, and repair tasks.
- Must be able to work on their own most of the time but also with other members of the Fairyland staff.
- Perform preventive and periodic maintenance as assigned
- Contribute to maintaining a quality, safe environment for guests and employees.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Knowledge and familiarity with materials used to perform various building, mechanical, and maintenance repair tasks... This includes all the trades; carpentry, plumbing, electrical, masonry, roofing, painting, mechanical and other related skills.

- The use and care of hand and power equipment necessary to perform various building and maintenance repairs.
- Use graphic instructions such as drawings, layouts, or other visual aids.
- On occasion produce written descriptions with clearly organized thoughts
- Work in small, cramped areas.
- Reach high work areas with ladders and/or scaffolding and work at heights greater than ten feet.
- Travel across rough, uneven, or rocky surfaces.
- Move heavy objects (50 pounds or more)
- Mix or work with cleaning fluids, chemicals, paints, cleaning agents or similar solutions using normal protective equipment.
- Work in a variety of weather conditions with exposure to the outdoor elements.
- Work safely without presenting a direct threat to self or others.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum education of High School Diploma or GED equivalent

- Minimum of 4 years professional hands-on knowledge and work experience in a variety of construction skills such as carpentry, plumbing, painting, mechanical, and minor electrical.
