



Medical Exemption Policy

1. **If an individual Guest has a medical condition that prohibits them from WEARING A MASK AT ALL, Children's Fairyland will accommodate under the following guidelines:**
 - a. This individual Guest, or their parent/guardian, must present both a medical note signed by a doctor *and* a negative COVID test taken within the last 72 hours. The medical note signed by a doctor must *clearly* state the Guest is unable to wear a mask due to a health condition.
 - b. Documentation must be provided at point of entry and reviewed by Fairyland management.
 - c. The unmasked Guest is required to maintain six feet of physical distance from other Guests (ones not in their own group) at all times, including in park lines, organized park activities, and all performances and shows.
 - d. To access rides, the unmasked Guest must wait at the physically distanced queuing area and present their wristband/identifier to the ride operator. Unmasked Guests may be required to wait two to three ride cycles before being loaded onto the ride. Wait time will vary by ride.

2. **If an individual Guest cannot wear a mask at all or can only wear a mask intermittently due to a medical condition but *cannot* provide a doctor's note and/or a negative COVID test, they will be permitted to remove their mask while they are sitting down and physically distanced from Guests not in their immediate group.**
